'MyDoom' e-mail virus spreads fast

The virus, dubbed "MyDoom" by anti-virus software maker Network Associates Inc. and "Novarg" by rival Symantec Corp., hit just after 4 p.m. EST, the companies said. But Matej Sustic, chief technology officer for Vancouver-based Fusepoint Managed Services Inc., said he first learned of its existence a week ago.
